Alma College offers international students opportunities for up to \$30,000 in scholarships.

International students may be considered for the following academic scholarships:

- Global Talent Award This scholarship is based on academic performance in secondary school. The course studies and marks/grades received will be considered.
- Global Leadership Students demonstrating evidence of extensive involvement in non-athletic school and community activities, leadership positions, and volunteer involvement will be considered for this award.
- Decisions are made at the time of admission.
- Deadline for consideration is May 1 for fall term entry and October 31 for winter term entry.

Fine Arts Scholarships – International students may audition for a performing arts award, or provide a portfolio for a visual arts award. Recipients are not required to major in fine arts to receive a scholarship.

- Theatre students are able to participate in all aspects of theatre production
- Highland Arts dancers, fiddlers, bagpipers, and drummers
