ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Completion of Grade 12 (or equivalent)

Minimum overall average of 70% in English and four other academic Grade 12 courses

International Baccalaureate (IB):

- 26 points
- HL courses with grades of 5, 6 or 7 may be eligible for university credit

Advance Placement (AP):

 AP courses with an exam result of 4 or 5 may be eligible for university credit
